JUDE

Jude

1:1 – Jude – Jude was one of the brothers of Jesus (Matthew 13:55). Jude was one of those who came to faith after Christ's resurrection. He wrote this letter between 60-65AD.

1:3 – once for all delivered to the saints – The faith we hold has been fully passed down to us. There is no expectation of continued or new revelation.

1:6 – kept in eternal chains – This is another picture of the binding of Satan and his demons during the gospel age (Revelation 20:1-3).

1:9 – There is no other mention of this account elsewhere in Scripture. It must have occurred after the death of Moses on the mountain.

1:17-23 – The false teachers have been described as dangerous, so Jude calls on his readers to persevere in their faith and to help others persevere as well.

1:24-25 – Because they are all prone to fall, Jude ends with the reminder that it is the Lord who will keep his people to the end.
